Food Security Situation*

- Chad is a low-income, food-deficit country, ranked 183 out of 187 countries in the 2011 UNDP Human Development Index. Over 500,000 refugees and IDPs reside in Chad, impacting the socio-economic situation and the depletion of natural resources.
- Crop damage from birds and insects has put the preliminary nationwide grain production estimate at below the five-year average. Poor pasture availability in the northern part of the country has triggered an earlier than usual seasonal migration by livestock southwards and has created prematurely large concentrations of animals in the same agropastoral area.
- Following the suspension of food imports from Libya, the demand for cereals in the North and pastoral areas is high. More than 50,000 Chadians have returned from Libya-- increasing competition for limited job opportunities and decrease household income, likely exacerbating food insecurity.
